In order to write a chapter summary template, the teacher must have all the materials available. Next, the teacher can go ahead and teach by using the "I do, we do, you do" model. Chapter in an edited book: Chapter in an edited book, reprinted from another book Do not create references for chapters of authored books. Instead, write a reference for the whole authored book and cite the chapter in the text if desired.

Your best bet here would be to provide a brief summary of the chapter on which you're writing—a couple of sentences should be sufficient—followed by your already written thesis statement (Your thesis statement should be the last sentence of your introduction). Your body paragraphs are practically written already.

Writing a Good Chapter Analysis - Stop Summarizing and ...

I always take the name of a character in the chapter (they have names based on words such as Path, Crown, Leaf) and use them to summarize what will happen. For example, when Crown disappears, the chapter is called Crownless, but the chapter also talks about how the duke needs to reign over his land again. I love playing with chapter's names.

Begin your summary by stating the main characters and setting of the chapter in one to two sentences. The main characters are who the story is about. They do most of the acting, feeling and talking in the chapter.
