The rational choice model The behavioural change theory that underlies much public policy is the rational choice model which assumes people rationally seek to maximise their welfare. People assess the choices before them in terms of costs and benefits and then select the choice that maximises their net benefits.

Changing behaviour: A public policy perspective ...

For instance, advocates have to make choices about when to seek policy changes, the appropriate policy outcome to pursue at a given point in time, and the best political venues to seek policy changes. One of the most known and controversial concepts of public policy is that of Thomas Dye, according to whom "public policy is whatever governments choose to do or not to do" (Dye, 1972: 2).

Evaluating the Effect of the Policy Change. The final stage in the public policy process, known as evaluation, is typically ongoing. This step usually involves a study of how effective the new policy has been in addressing the original problem, which often leads to additional public policy changes.

What are the Steps in the Public Policy Process?

A conventional and general definition of public policy instruments is "a set of techniques by which governmental authorities wield their power in attempting to ensure support and effect (or prevent) social change" : 21. This definition puts an emphasis on the purposive nature of policy instruments.
