Implementing and Enforcing Student Dress Codes Communicating the dress code. The student dress code, including any changes in dress requirements must be: communicated widely throughout the school community; provided to all prospective students and parents and carers prior to enrolment at the school; translated into community languages, if required

STUDENT DRESS CODES: WHAT'S FAIR?

The implementation of student dress codes has increased over the past decade. The essence of the dress codes vary in reach. Some codes mandate specific uniforms, such as khaki or navy pants with a specific color polo or oxford shirt. Other codes ban specific items, such as flip-flops, midriffs, clothing with particular symbols, or clothing in particular colors.

The First Ammendment and Student Dress Codes

Student dress codes are common but highly variable. Courts will support student dress and grooming code provisions that are necessary to maintain an educational environment that is free from substantial distractions and disruptions. Courts, however, will not support regulations of student appearance that reflect little more than officials' personal

Over the years, schools have implemented student dress codes to address a wide range of issues, some of which have been quite controversial. For example, in the late 1960s and 70s, young men with long hair were sometimes physically attacked by their classmates and, as a result, many schools required boys to wear their hair cut to their ears or shorter.

District-wide standards on student attire are intended to encourage school pride and unity, and thereby help students concentrate on schoolwork, reduce discipline problems, and improve school order and safety.

Dress Code / STUDENT DRESS CODE

Dress codes and school uniforms have existed in America for more than 100 years. The constitutionality of these codes was first challenged in a 1969 U.S. Supreme Court case called Tinker v. Des Moines, which involved students who were banned by their school district from wearing black armbands to school to protest the Vietnam War.

Many school districts claim stringent dress codes increase their emphasis on academics, disperse gang activity, and reduce pressures stemming from socioeconomic status. But they can also violate a student's First Amendment right to freedom of expression and a parent's Fourteenth Amendment right to raise their children as they choose.
