CE marking is an administrative marking that indicates conformity with health, safety, and environmental protection standards for products sold within the European Economic Area (EEA). In countries where "common law" applies, their use of the mark before your trademark filing also gives them a claim to property rights depending on the scope of their use of the mark. If the other mark owner used their trademark for a limited time in a limited area, you might be able to resubmit a registration application with Trademark Office.

Trademark Registration Process in the European Union

The European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) administers the EU trademark (EUTM). An EUTM is a pending or formal registration of a trademark recognized across the entire EU community rather than acknowledged country by country. The mark holder does not have to reside in a member country to apply for the EUTM.

Priority. Trade marks are protected on a 'first come, first served' basis. Trade mark protection begins when a legal filing date is given. However, when establishing who has filed first, it is not only the filing date of the potential competitor's trade mark that has to be taken into account, but also any priority date.
